

**Regulations for participation  
in Central European Summer School - Summer School  
in Lanckorona - Tyniec on July 23 - August 1, 2018.**

- 1) The organizer of the Central European Summer School in Lanckorona - Tyniec on July 23 - August 1, 2018 (hereinafter referred to as the "Summer School") is The Centre for the Thought of John Paul II, a self-government cultural institution of the Capital City of Warsaw, based in Warsaw, at Foksal 11, entered into the register of the cultural institutions of the capital city of Warsaw under No. 1/2006, having Tax identification Number 5252357081 and Regon 140469560 (hereinafter referred to as the: "Organizer").
- 2) The goal of the Summer School is to strengthen the leadership potential of young people interested in the culture of Central and Eastern Europe by introducing them to the example of John Paul II - the thinker and model of life.
- 3) The Organizer sets the Summer School program and reserves the right to introduce changes in the program in justified cases, in particular in the scope of changing the time schedule and the sequence of classes. The framework program of the Summer School is available on the Organizer's website.
- 4) No more than 27 participants will be qualified to participate in the Summer School.
- 5) The Organizer covers the cost of accommodation, meals, tickets to museums, transport of participants during the Summer School, training materials. The participant of the Summer School is obliged to cover the costs of transport to the place where the Summer School takes place and back to home.
- 6) The organizer does not provide insurance participants. Participants are required to cover their insurance costs themselves.
- 7) Classes during the Summer School are in English.
- 8) Participants of the Summer School may be people aged 18-36.
- 9) The condition for participation in the recruitment to the Summer School is sending the correctly completed application form available at:

- 10) to: [registration@centrumjp2.pl](mailto:registration@centrumjp2.pl) - an essay, wrote in English of up to 4,000 characters (with spaces) on one of two subjects:
  - a) What is the most important change you want to make in the world and how do you plan to achieve it?,
  - b) Which leader of your country would you call an "integrated person" and why? and
- 11) a recommendation letter from a university worker or a letter of recommendation from the employer - to the e-mail address: [registration@centrumjp2.pl](mailto:registration@centrumjp2.pl)

10. The Organizer, on the basis of sent documents, selects the participants of the Summer School, evaluating the completeness of the application and assessing submitted applications on a point scale of 1 point up to 10 points, taking into account - in case of an essay - an original view on the topic of work, the quality of arguments, logical coherence of the reasoning, the multiplicity of perceived aspects related to the topic, linguistic correctness and aesthetic essay (0-5 points) and - in the case of motivation registration in the application form - self-development, social and civic engagement in the spirit of John Paul II teaching, involvement in the development of the cultural and historical heritage of Central and Eastern Europe (0-5 points). Persons whose essays and motivations of the application have been rated with the highest number of points are qualified for the Summer School. The organizer will send the results of recruitment to the Summer School by e-mail until 18.06.2018. If the number of essays that obtain the appropriate number of points exceeds the number of places available at the Summer School, a reserve list of participants of the Summer School is created.
11. The person to whom information about a positive recruitment result has been sent should immediately, but no later than within 5 days from the date of receiving the information, confirm their participation in the Summer School by sending confirmation to the e-mail address: registration @ centrumjp2. pl. Sending confirmation is tantamount to reserving by the Organizer a place for the person to whom the application relates. Failure to send confirmation of participation in the Summer School is treated as resignation from participation in the Summer School.
12. A participant who has confirmed his/her participation in the Summer School may resign from participation in the Summer School without bearing the costs referred to in point 13, by 1 July 2018 at the latest, by sending a written statement of resignation to the address of the Organizer's registered office.
13. Resignation from participation in the Summer School after 01.07.2018 obliges the participant to cover the costs incurred by the Organizer for booking his/her participation in the Summer School in the amount of PLN 1500.00, unless the resignation is caused by random and extraordinary circumstances, to which the participant was not able to prevent.
14. The fee for participation in the Summer School is PLN 500. The Organizer allows the possibility of co-financing participation in the Summer School in the amount of 100% coverage or 80% of the registration fee, provided that the application for co-financing is submitted to the e-mail address: registration@centrumjp2.pl, whose form is attached as Appendix no. 1 to these Regulations. Co-financing in the amount of 100% of the fee will be granted to 10 people who submitted the application for co-financing, in the order of the amount of their monthly gross income per one family member. The remaining participants of the Summer School may be granted co-financing in the amount of 80% of the fee, in the order of their gross monthly income per one family member, until the funds are exhausted. In

case of submitting more applications for co-financing for the same amount of gross monthly income, the order of applications decides.

15. The fee must be paid to the Organizer's account indicated below until 30 June 2018:

16. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Summer School in case of random events (including fire, breakdown in the building where the Summer School is to take place or other random events, the occurrence of which prevents the organization of the Summer School according to the program or threatens the life or health of participants of the Summer School if it is held). In this case, the fees paid by the participants will be refunded in full.
17. The participant of the Summer School undertakes to follow the safety rules and to follow the Organizer's instructions and technical and organizational instructions during the Summer School.
18. The Organizer may expel a participant from the Summer School during the course because of his/her behaviour is blameworthy, dangerous, inconsistent with the universally binding law or accepted social norms.
19. Along with submitting participation in the recruitment, the person applying for participation in the Summer School agrees to the sharing and processing of personal data by the Organizer - the Centre for the Thought of John Paul II with its registered office in Warsaw (00-372) at Foksal 11, to organize and run the Summer School.
20. The Organizer informs that the administrator of personal data of the participants of the Summer School is the Centre of Thought of John Paul II with its registered office in Warsaw (00-372), at Foksal 11 and that the data are processed in accordance with art. 6 par. 1 lett. a of Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016. Consent to the processing of personal data of participants of the Summer School may be cancelled at any time by sending a relevant message to the following e-mail address: [registration@centrumjp2.pl](mailto:registration@centrumjp2.pl), which will result in the participant's data being removed from the resources of the Centre for the Thought of John Paul II. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing which was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. The data of the participant of the Summer School is voluntary but it is not possible to attend the Summer School without providing it.
21. Participants of the Summer School have the right to access their data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to raise objections, and the right to lodge a complaint to the appropriate supervisory authority, when they consider that the processing of their personal data violates the provisions rights.

Participants of the Summer School acknowledge that the Summer School project will be photographed and recorded using video cameras and as part of the Summer School they agree to record and the image and voice recorded on the photographic and video material, in whole or in any fragments will be published, including images and statements of other people, at any time, on any audio-visual medium, in particular on video, photosensitive magnetic tape and a computer disk, in a multimedia network, including the Organizer's websites, as well as in information and promotion materials related to the Summer School.

22. Application to participate in the Summer School is tantamount to acceptance of these Regulations.
23. The Organizer reserves the right to change the Regulations in justified cases, as well as to finish the recruitment to the Summer School without selecting the participants of the Summer School.
24. The Regulations have been drawn up in two language versions: Polish and English; in the event of discrepancies between these versions, the Polish language version shall prevail; in matters not regulated in the regulations, the provisions of Polish law shall apply, and the court competent for resolving disputes shall be the common court in Poland, competent for the seat of the Organizer.
25. Regulations come into force on the day of its announcement.
